IECEX Certified Pressurised Hot Work Habitats (Suitable for Zone 1 & 2)

It is a little-known, but critically important requirement, that only pressurised habitat systems that are 3rd party certified to standard IEC60079-13 can legally be operated within Zone 1 & 2 hazardous areas in Australia.

The Safespear Pressurhab Safe – Stop Zone 1 control system is designed and 3rd party certified to the IEC60079-13 standard for use in conjunction with our highly fire resistant welding habitats. Safe-Stop creates a safe overpressure differential between the inside and outside of the habitat.

This in essence acts as a physical barrier between the ignition source (hot work) and the explosion source (gas). The Safespear Pressurehab can be used for any type of hot work such as welding, cutting and grinding in a hazardous area without the need for shutdown.

Benefits include:

- > Provision of an engineered control for the safe execution of hot work in an explosive environment
- > Maximising production uptime by minimising requirements for facility shutdown
- > Increased worker productivity
